Day 01, 30 MAR: SYDNEY – SHANGHAI
MU 736, 30 MAR. SYDNEY – SHANGHAI 21:30/05:00
(31 MAR.)

Depart to Shanghai in the evening and arrive in Shanghai in the morning. You will fly overnight.

Day 02, 31 MAR: SHANGHAI – NARITA
MU 727, 31 MAR. SHANGHAI – NARITA 07:55/12:00
Connect your flight in Shanghai to Narita airport and upon arrival, you are met and transferred to hotel in Tokyo, capital of Japan for your Japan tour.
Accommodation: Prince Hotel, Sunshine City**** or similar

Day 03, 01 APR: TOKYO SIGHTSEEING (B.L.D.)

Today's tour includes Observatory of Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building, Asakusa Temple, a very popular Buddhist temple, built in the 7th century, the Edo Museum, Imperial Palace, home of Imperial family, which only opens to public on 23rd December and 02nd January each year. Continue to visit Ginza, Tokyo, brand name shopping area, same as New York 5th Avenue and Shinjuku area. After dinner, check into your Tokyo hotel for the night.
Accommodation: Prince Hotel, Sunshine City**** or similar

Day 04, 02 APR: TOKYO – HAKONE – KAWAGUCHIKO (B.L.D.)

After breakfast visit Hakone, Peace Park and Owakutani Hot Spring. Take a pleasure cruise around Lake Ashi Cruise, which offers marvelous views of Mt. Fuji. Stay overnight in Kawaguchiko.
Accommodation: Just One Hotel, Fujiyama**** or similar

Day 05, 03 APR: HAKONE – TOYOHASHI (B.L.D.)

After breakfast, drive half-way to Mt Fuji. Visit Visitor Centre and Green tea farm. Take a Bullet Train to Toyohashi from Hamamatsu. Stay overnight in Toyohashi.
Accommodation: Loisir Hotel, Toyohashi**** or Similar

Day 06, 04 APR: TOYOHASHI – KYOTO – OSAKA (B.L.D.)

After breakfast, drive to Kyoto, the Japan's ancient capital. Upon arrival, visit Arashiyama, Heian Shrine, Kiyomizu



Temple and Golden Pavilion. Also enjoy a Nishijin Kimono Show. Stay overnight in Osaka.

Accommodation: Crystal Hotel**** or similar



Day 07, 05 APR: OSAKA – NARA – OSAKA (B.L.D)

After breakfast, drive to Nara, Japan's first ancient capital. Upon arrival, visit Deer park and Todaiji Temple with a great image of Buddha. After lunch, drive back to Osaka. Start your city sightseeing in Osaka including the Osaka Castle and visit Shinzaibashi Shopping Area. Stay overnight in Osaka. Accommodation: Crystal Hotel**** or similar

Day 08, 06 APR: OSAKA – INCHEON, SEOUL (B.D)

OZ 115, 06 APR. OSAKA (KIX) – INCHEON 09:10/11:00

After breakfast, you are transferred to airport for your flight to Incheon, Seoul, capital of South Korea. Upon arrival in Seoul, you are met and start your sightseeing tour to Changdoeok

Palace (Secret Garden), Insadong Antique shop alley, Myeongdong shopping street and Cheon Gye Cheon Stream.

Accommodation: Ibis Yongsan Hotel**** or similar

Day 09, 07 APR: SEOUL – ANDONG – GYEONGJU (B.L.D)

You will drive to Gyeongju. Along the way, you will make a stop in Andong. Upon arrival in Andong, you will first explore Hahoe Village, a UNESCO World Heritage site renowned for its well-preserved traditional Korean architecture and rich cultural heritage. Here, you can also learn about the Hahoe Mask Dance, a traditional Korean mask dance that is typically held during the Andong International Mask Dance Festival or on special occasions.

After the tour in Andong, you will be transferred to Gyeongju (about 1.5 hours' drive). Upon arrival, visit Gyeongju Donggung Palace and Wolji Pond, a secondary palace used by the crown prince of the Silla Kingdom. You can enjoy the reflection of Imhaejeon in Wolji during the night.

Accommodation: The K Hotel, Gyeongju**** or similar

Day 10, 08 APR: GYEONGJU – SEOUL (B.L.D)

After breakfast at your hotel, visit Seokguram Grotto (UNESCO), constructed by Kim Dae-Seong during the reign of King Gyeong-Deok (742-765) of the Silla Kingdom.

Afterwards, travel to Seoul and stay overnight in Seoul.

Accommodation: Ibis Yongsan Hotel**** or similar

Day 11, 09 APR: SEOUL – DMZ – SEOUL (B.L.D)

After breakfast, drive to visit DMZ (Passport is required to join). We will visit Imjingak Park, the Unification Bridge, ID Check, DMZ theater and exhibition hall, the 3rd Infiltration Tunnel, Dora Observatory. Afterwards, back to Seoul and have an orientation city tour.

Accommodation: Ibis Yongsan Hotel**** or similar

Day 12, 10 APR: SEOUL – SHANGHAI – SYDNEY (B.L)

MU5034, 10 APR. INCHEON – SHANGHAI (PVG) 16:20/17:30

MU 561, 10 APR. SHANGHAI (PVG) – SYDNEY 20:20/09:00 (11 APR.)

Visit Nami Island including Petite France & Italian Village. You will have a chance to visit Alpaca World and take a



Samaksan Cable Car to watch stunning mountain views. After lunch, you are transferred to airport for your flight home to Sydney or Melbourne via Shanghai.

Day 13, 11 APR: SYDNEY ARRIVAL

You arrive in Sydney in the morning and your unforgettable Japan and Korea tour ends.
